Homework Policy (2026/2027)

(1) Aims:

- To consolidate classroom learning, extend and strengthen students' learning;
- To help students understand their own learning progress and problems, and subsequently seek methods to resolve difficulties;
- To cultivate students' self-discipline and self-learning abilities.
- To serve as teaching feedback, allowing teachers to understand students' learning situations, identify their learning difficulties, and thereby adjust teaching pace and methods.
- To allow parents to understand their child's learning situation and provide timely support; fostering cooperation to jointly help students improve their learning.

(2) Homework Design Model:

- Integrate with classroom teaching progress to help students consolidate learning and develop concepts.
- Suit students' learning needs and abilities, catering to their diverse learning needs.
- Utilize diverse formats to stimulate students' learning motivation, and through providing interesting and challenging tasks, cultivate students' habit of autonomous learning.
- Encourage reading and foster students' reading habits.

(3) Homework Arrangements:

- Teachers will assign homework according to the teaching schedule and record it via the eClass homework diary for students and parents to check. Homework should be completed according to the teacher's instructions.
- Primary 6 students are required to fill in their homework diary daily for parents to review.
- Students must complete their homework at home and submit it by the specified date.
- If a student fails to submit homework by the specified time, the teacher will arrange for the student to attend an after-school homework tutorial class to complete the relevant homework.
- During long holidays, various subjects will assign an appropriate amount of homework to allow students to make good use of the holiday for extended learning.

(4) Parental Cooperation:

- Encourage your child to complete homework seriously at home, helping them understand their own learning situation and continuously improve.
- Understand your child's difficulties and needs in order to provide timely support.
- Maintain close contact with the school. If there are difficulties, discuss them early with the teacher or social worker.
- Ensure your child has sufficient rest time to develop personal interests and potential, and to establish a balanced and healthy lifestyle.
